Daily Weather Briefing and Overview | January 21st, 2014 New York City, NY

Watches, Warnings, Advisories: Winter Storm Warning (NJ, NYC, SE NY, CT, LI) Winter Weather Advisory (Far NW NJ, Interior NY)

Hazards: Developing snow by afternoon. The snow will become heavy at times by late afternoon into the evening hours, continuing into the overnight.

Overview: A significant winter storm will develop during the day on Tuesday, and affect the majority of the forecast area. Lesser impacts are expected in the far interior suburbs, and greater impacts near the coast. Moderate snow will overspread the area during the early to mid afternoon hours with some light accumulations. The heavier snow begins after 4pm and is expected to bring rapid accumulations, especially in bands of heavier snow which are expected to form near the area coasts. Snowfall rates of 1-2" per hour are possible. Snow continues into the overnight period before tapering off by the early morning on Wednesday.
