Daily Weather Briefing and Overview | January 28th, 2014 New York City, NY

Hazards: Black ice in the morning

Overview: An Arctic cold front is crossing the region, which will lead to a much colder day on Tuesday than on Monday. Gusty west and northwest winds, combined with temperatures struggling to get to 20 degrees will lead to Wind Chills starting between 0 and 5 below, and increasing to around 5 above during the day. Skies will predominately be partly cloudy, but thin mid and high cirrus and stratus clouds will be on the increase during the evening, as we watch a storm system coming from the south, which may graze coastal areas with light snow after 10:00pm. 1-2" for coastal locations appears possible by Wednesday morning.
